1. The purpose of this modification is to incorporate minor updates to the Spyrus Rosetta CSI CAC Middleware under SUBCLIN 0001AA to this contract as follows:

SUBCLIN 0001AA The new version number for the Rosetta CSI CAC Middleware is v4 Build 40f Service Pack 1a

Some of the features implemented by this new version upgrade include the following:

- (1) Added Windows XP Professional as a supported operating system
- (2) Modified software to permit public certificates to be accessed without requiring PIN validation
- (3) XSI/BSI extensions were updated to include previously unsupported functions.
- (4) Fixed bug in Token Manager
- (5) Added device name to PIN prompt dialog.
- (6) Fixed bug where enumerating containers failed.
- (7) Fixed bug in self-registration that caused it to fail on Windows NT4.
- (8) Added support for Wave Systems Embassy 2100 Secure PIN entry reader.
- (9) Added support to enable concurrent DMS messaging and CAC usage.
- (10) Added Systray utility
- (11) Added Version Viewer utility

2. Incorporation of the new version v4 Build 40f Service Pack 1a does not affect the form, fit or functionality of the CAC Middleware nor its compliance to the CAC Release 1.0 Middleware Requirements Specification, Version 2.2 dated 7 Mar 2002.

3. The Army is hereby removed from participation in the fee-sharing program. To accommodate this change, Paragraph B6 found on pages 14 and 15 of the Contract is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

**B6. Fees and Payments**

a. **Acquisition, Contracting, and Technical (ACT) Fee.** The cost of awarding, administering and managing this Contract is included in the prices charged to ordering activities. The ACT fee is 2%. Remittance of the ACT fee shall be made on a calendar quarterly basis (i.e. January - March, April - June, July - September, and October - December) or as otherwise requested by the Software Product Manager (SPM) and is due thirty (30) days following the completion of the reporting period. Negative reports are required. ACT fees that have not been paid within the prescribed thirty (30) days shall be considered a debt to the United States Government under the terms of FAR 32.6. The Government may exercise all its rights under the contract, including withholding or setting off payments and interest on the debt (see FAR 52.232-17, Interest). Failure of the Contractor to pay the ACT fee in a timely manner may result in termination of the Contract.

b. **Fee Distribution.** The Navy and Air Force are participating in a fee-sharing program. The contractor shall collect the 2% ACT fee and distribute in accordance with the following procedures. Fee sharing shall be determined by the End User Agency or Service identified in the monthly Report of Sales. This field shall be notated DON, DOA, DOAF or DOD as appropriate. Do not issue fee checks until written approval is received for the Report of Sales.

**ALL SALES:**

The 2% ACT fee is split equally between the DoD Component whose customer places the order and the DoD Component that manages the ESI agreement. In other words, any Air Force order against an ESI agreement managed by the Navy results in a 1% portion of the 2% fee being returned to the Air Force acquisition organization (listed under Air Force Sales). The Navy will retain the entire 2% fee under orders issued for Navy activities or those activities that do not collect a fee under the ESI agreements managed by the Navy. The contractor is responsible for distributing the ACT fee to all applicable Services in accordance with the instructions herein. The amount of ACT fee due the Financial Management Office (FMO) shall be calculated at 1% for Air Force sales and 2% for all other sales.
