Notification of Government Security Activity Clause (52.204-9000) (SEP 85), and Visitor Group Security Agreements (52.204-9001), applies. Notification must be supplied to SSPO 30 days prior to classified access. Secret clearance is required for maintenance personnel at time of system delivery. User sites that require clearance for maintenance personnel will be identified at the time of issuance of the delivery order. Maintenance personnel will be identified at the time of issuance of the delivery order. Maintenance personnel and on-site analyst and engineering support personnel performing service at a Government site that does not require a security clearance may be either U.S. citizens or foreign nationals provided there is no risk of gaining access to either sensitive, classified, or technical controlled data and information.

Otherwise, the NATO clearance would have to be considered on a case-by-case basis.
