

SECTION D

PACKAGING AND MARKING

D1 Packaging and Marking.

The Contractor shall be responsible for the preservation, packaging, packing, unpacking, and placement of all items to be delivered under the terms of this contract in accordance with the requirements of the MIL-STD listed below. The Contractor's commercial preservation, packaging and packing practices shall be acceptable for CONUS shipments - via surface for immediate use if these practices provide the required protection. Marking for purchased equipment shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129L. The required Levels of protection are:

1.1 (CONUS - Immediate Use - when delivery to final destination will be made within 30 days from the date shipped from Contractor's facility)

- Level C preservation and packaging, and Level C packing.

1.2 (CONUS - when delivery to final destination will be made over 30 days after the date shipped from Contractor's facility)

- Level B preservation and packaging, and Level C packing.

1.3 (Overseas - Surface Shipments)

- Level A - preservation and packaging, and Level A packing.

1.4 (Overseas - Air Shipment)

- Level B preservation and packaging, and Level C packing.
